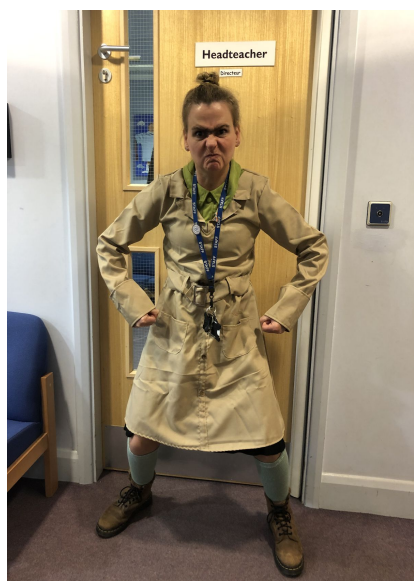


Blue Class
