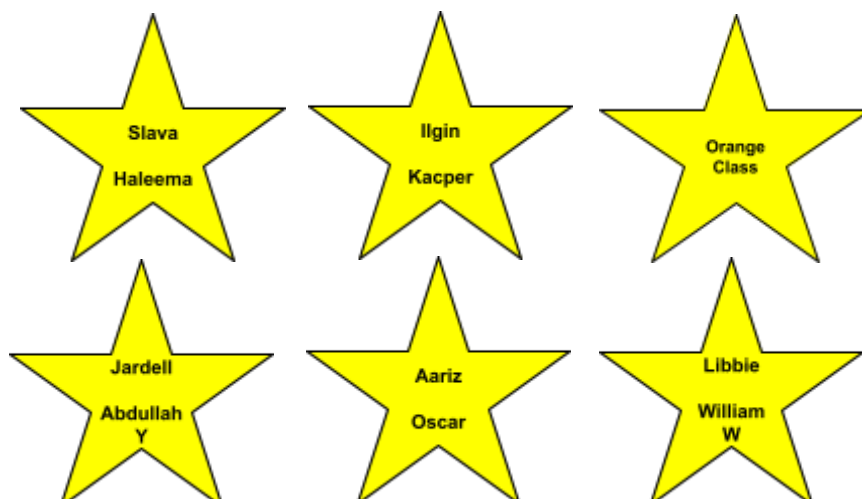

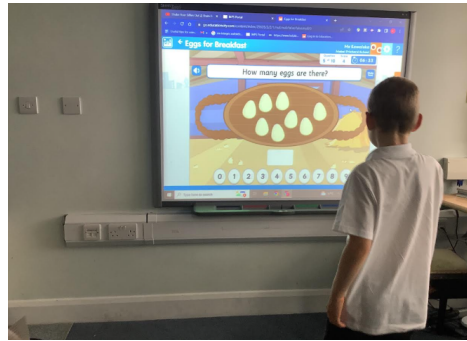


Blue Class

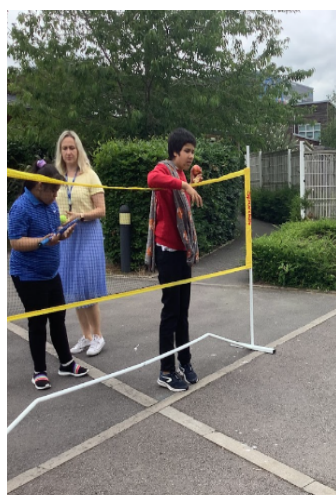
